Gearing Up For EOC Activation

WHAT THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION IS DOING:

NOW

- Continuously Monitoring the Tropics
- Coordinating with Partner Agencies
- Ensuring EOC and Personnel Readiness

IMPACTS POSSIBLE

3-7 Days Prior

- Communicating with National Weather Service
- Issuing Spot Reports
- Making Preparations at Home and the EOC

TROPICAL WATCH ISSUED

Tropical Conditions Possible Within 48 Hours

- Implementing the "Planning P"
- Issuing Situation Reports
- Staffing EOC Positions
- Making Final Evacuation and Shelter Decisions

TROPICAL WARNING ISSUED

Tropical Conditions Expected Within 36 Hours

- Sustaining EOC Operations
- Planning for the Operational Period
- Communicating with Partners About Operational Needs



Maintain Operations:

- Update EOC Staff About Agency Operations and Needs
- Maintain Essential Staff
- Communicate Storm Updates to Agency Personnel

Sign Up To Receive:

- Daily Situation Report
- ReadyOp Updates
- WebEOC Access

Review:

- Continuity of Operations Plans
- Communications Plans

Stay Informed:

- Prepare Your Agency and Their Families
- Communicate Plans With Essential Personnel
- Stay In Communication With EOC Staff



Ensure Accountability:

- Communicate Unmet Needs to EOC
- Ensure Staff Accountability and Safety
- Make Final Sheltering and Evacuation Decisions
