## Recovery Begins Before Disaster Strikes

### WHAT THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION IS DOING:

#### NOW

- Continuously Monitoring the Tropics
- Coordinating with Partner Agencies
- Ensuring EOC and Personnel Readiness

#### IMPACTS POSSIBLE

- Communicating with internal and external stakeholders
- Ensuring partner agencies have appropriate documentation
- Making preparations at home and the EOC

#### IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING IMPACT

- Coordinating with JSO and JFRD for Cursonry Damage Assessment
- Communicating with Internal and External Partners to Determine Extent of Damage
- Assigning Individual Damage Assessment Teams
- Further Inspect Reports from the Field

#### IN THE DAYS FOLLOWING IMPACT

- Compiling Estimated Financial Impacts from all Eligible Entities within Duval County
- Communicating the Scope and Extent of Impacts within Duval County
- If Warranted, Completing a Request for Public Assistance

#### IN THE WEEKS FOLLOWING

- Coordinating with Internal and External Partners to Refine Damage Assessment
- Quantifying and Qualifying the Scope and Breadth of Financial Impacts and Communicating Them to the State and FEMA
- Communicating with Internal and External Partners for FDEM/FEMA Just-in-Time Training

### WHAT YOUR AGENCY SHOULD BE DOING:



#### Stay Informed:

- Prepare Your Agency and Their Families
- Communicate Plans With Essential Personnel
- Stay In Communication With EOC Staff

#### Sign Up To Receive:

- Daily Situation Report
- ReadyOp Updates
- WebEOC Access

#### Review:

- Post Disaster Recovery Plans
- Procurement Rules



#### Ensure Accountability

- Communicate Disaster Impacts to the EOC
- Ensure Staff Are Completing Necessary Paperwork for Transition to Recovery
- Ensure Staff Are Able to Assess Personal Disaster Impacts and Family Status

#### Maintain Operations

- Post-Disaster Cleanup Operations, Separating and Moving Debris to the Right-of-Way
- Continue to Refine Financial Impacts and Communicate Them to the EOC
- Monitor Guidance from City and EOC to Ensure Benchmarks and Milestones are not Missed
